Two cousins bond after a night of hard partying.

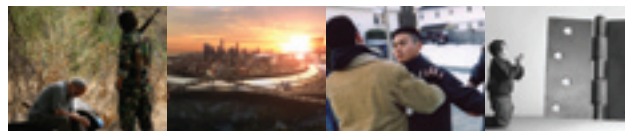
